

Instructions for Producing an Abstract for Publication in Book of Abstracts Using \LaTeX ¹

All participants interested in contributing to the International Bogolyubov Conference on PROBLEMS OF THEORETICAL AND MATHEMATICAL PHYSICS dedicated to the 100th anniversary of the birth of N.N. Bogolyubov (1909 – 1992), which will be held from **21 to 27 August 2009**, at Moscow — Dubna, Russia, are invited to submit one-page abstract of their contribution. A booklet containing the abstracts of the invited talks and all accepted contributed papers will be distributed to registered participants upon arrival.

The source LaTeX file of this document constitutes a template for the style and layout of the abstracts to be submitted as contributions to the Conference. The title of the abstract (in large bold type style) should be followed by the name of all authors (in normal type), and their institutions with complete mailing address (written in small font size). Underline the author presenting the talk if there are more than one author. Use superscript small letters to indicate the different affiliations of the authors. References should be quoted using arabic numerals between square brackets, like [1] or [2-4], and listed at the end of the abstract.

Each contribution must be submitted in the form of a latex and pdf file, and sent by E-mail to the Conference Organizing Committee:

Submission by regular mail or fax is not acceptable. The deadline for submission of abstracts is:

May 1, 2009

Each abstract must be accompanied by the following information, in the body of the e-mail message:

- Title of the topic for which the abstract is submitted (refer to the Conference Topics on the website: <http://bog2009.jinr.ru/>).
- Name, e-mail address of a single contact participant.
